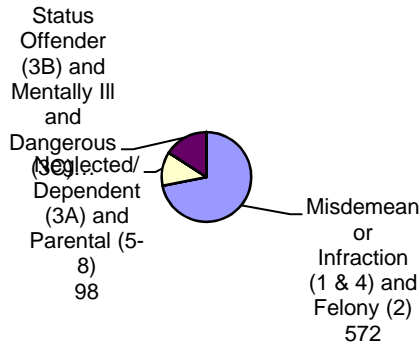

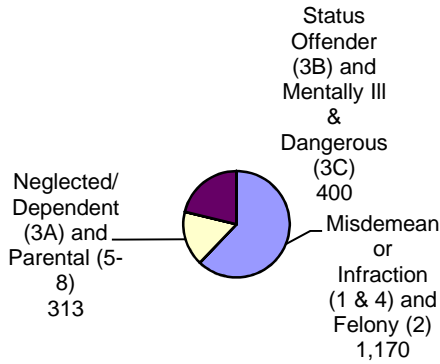

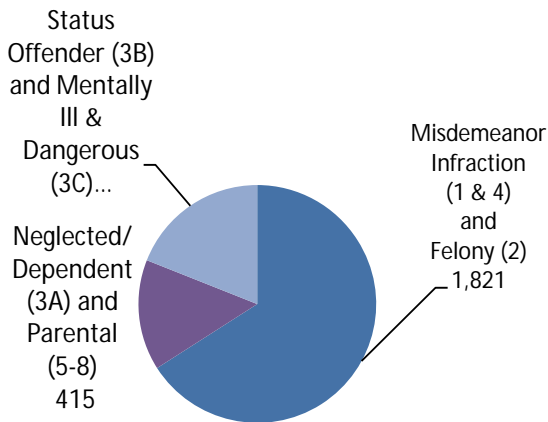

Juvenile Court jurisdiction is defined in Nebraska Statute §43-247

- (1) misdemeanor
- (2) felony
- (3a) abuse, neglect or dependency
- (3b) truancy or ungovernable
- (4) traffic infraction
- (5) parental jurisdiction
- (6) and (7) termination of parental rights
- (8) child relinquished to DHHSS
