


Statewide Recidivism Rate



of youth that were successfully discharged from Probation, were found responsible for a subsequent qualifying adjudication within one year of their release. This current recidivism rate is reported as of September 30, 2022.

Recidivism by Risk Level

As predicted by the validated risk assessment tool, Youth Level of Risk/Case Management Inventory (YLS/CMI), the population of low risk youth who discharged successfully between September 30, 2019 and September 30, 2020 recidivated at a lower rate than the population of moderate or high risk youth.
