Action taken by the Trial Court: The trial court found in favor of Nebraska Bank of Commerce (NBC) for breach of a settlement agreement, conversion of funds, breach of fiduciary duty, and fraud in the inducement. The trial court found in favor of VanEiser for breach of contract.

Assignments of Error on Appeal: Did the trial court err in finding that NBC did not fraudulently induce VanEiser to enter into the settlement agreement, breach the settlement agreement, convert funds owed to VanEiser, and breach a fiduciary duty owed to VanEiser?

Assignments of Error on Cross-Appeal: Did the trial court err in determining that NBC was not entitled to the \$12,500 fee it charged for conducting the auction sale of the VanEiser assets?
