Action Taken by Trial Court: After a stipulated bench trial, the district court found Appellant guilty. The court subsequently sentenced Appellant to 8 to 12 years' imprisonment.

Assignments of Error on Appeal: On appeal, Appellant alleges that the district court erred in overruling his motion to suppress evidence obtained during a warrantless search of his apartment and his motion to suppress statements he made to police at the time of the search.
