Action Taken by Trial Court: The trial court found that appellee was an odd lot employee, held appellee was permanently totally disabled, and awarded outstanding medical expenses, future medical expenses, and a vocational rehabilitation evaluation.

Assignments of Error on Appeal: Appellant assigns the district court erred in 1) failing to provide a reasoned and meaningful decision when it failed to address appellee?s credibility, 2) failing to provide a reasoned and meaningful decision when it adopted the restrictions provided by appellee?s physician, and 3) finding that Appellee is an odd lot employee.
