Case Summary**A-17-852, Clark (Appellant) v. Clark**

Workman's Compensation Action: Child Support

Action Taken by Trial Court: Court dismissed appellant's complaint for lack of sufficient evidence to make a determination between competing cases in differing jurisdictions and lack of jurisdiction over an out-of-state proceeding.

Assignments of Error on Appeal: Appellant assigns the district court erred in (1) determining there was insufficient evidence to make a determination between competing child support cases in differing jurisdictions; (2) determining it did not have jurisdiction over the out-of-state matter to determine which state's order was the controlling child support order; (3) failing to determine which state's order was the controlling child support order; and (4) failing to vacate or modify appellant's Nebraska child support obligations.
