Civil Action: Appointment of guardianship and conservatorship of alleged incapacitated and protected person

Action Taken by Trial Court: The court declined to appoint a permanent guardian for appellant but did appoint a conservator to manage her financial affairs.

Assignments of Error on Appeal: Did the trial court err in determining there was substantial evidence that appellant had been unable to manage her financial affairs for a substantial period of time? Did the trial court err in appointing a conservator for appellant?

Assignments of Error on Cross-Appeal: Did the trial court err in failing to find there was clear and convincing evidence that appellant required the appointment of a guardian? Did the trial court err in failing to find appellant required a full guardianship? Did the trial court err in failing to appoint a guardian for appellant?
