Proceedings Below: A charitable foundation filed a motion in the district court to appoint additional directors and schedule a meeting of the directors. The guardian and conservator of a serving member of the board of director filed a motion to dismiss. The district court denied the motion to dismiss, appointed four additional directors, and scheduled a meeting of the board.

Issues: Whether 1) the trial court has the authority to appoint additional directors; and 2) a guardian and conservator have the authority to act on behalf of the protected person with respect to appointments on boards of directors.
