Criminal: Plea; Post-release supervision revocation; Sentencing

Proceedings below: Appellant plead no contest to one count of terroristic threats and was sentenced to three years imprisonment and 18 months post-release supervision. Appellant plead no contest to the State's motion for revocation of post-release supervision and was sentenced to 365 days incarceration in county jail.

Issues: The trial court erred in 1) extending Appellant's remaining term of post-release supervision upon revocation; 2) failing to give Appellant the jail credit for time spent in jail pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §47-503; 3) imposing an illegal sentence; and 4) in an abuse of discretion, ordering an excessive sentence.
