Proceedings below: Following a jury trial, Appellant was convicted and sentenced to a combined term of life imprisonment plus 65 to 75 years.

Issues: The district court committed reversible error by denying Appellant's motion to suppress cell phone data content acquired as a result of the execution of a general search warrant, unsupported by probable cause.
