Proceedings Below: Following a negotiated plea agreement, the court accepted the plea agreement, found Appellant guilty of possession of a firearm by a prohibited person, attempted first-degree assault, and use of a weapon to commit a felony. The court the sentenced Appellant to a total of 42 to 55 years in prison with credit for 368 days served.

Issues: Whether Appellant's sentence constituted an abuse of the trial court's discretion and whether Appellant was denied effective assistance of counsel.
