Proceedings below: District court granted the State's motion for summary judgment and dismissed Appellant's amended complaint with prejudice.

Issues: Restated, the district court erred in 1) entering orders denying Appellant's motions to alter or amend judgment and dismissing the case, and 2) granting the State's converted motion for summary judgment and dismissed Appellant's amended complaint because Neb. Rev. Stat § 25-201.01 served to toll the six-month statute of limitations in the STCA.
