Proceedings below: The district court denied Appellant's motion, and renewed motion, to suppress all evidence relating to a breath test result. A jury found Appellant guilty of aggravated DUI. The district court denied Appellant's motion for a new trial.

Issues: Whether the district court erred in denying Appellant's motion to suppress, and her motion for a new trial. Appellant also argues ineffective assistance of counsel, and that the State violated her due process rights when it unknowingly or recklessly used false testimony.
