S-19-0275 State of Nebraska v. Jessica J. Lang (Appellant)

Hall County District Court, Judge Mark J. Young

Criminal: Possession of a controlled substance; Possession of marijuana; Possession of drug paraphernalia

Proceedings below: The trial court overruled Appellant?s motion to suppress and her motions to determine competency. Following a stipulated bench trial, Appellant was convicted of the crimes charged and sentenced.

Issues: Whether the trial court erred in 1) overruling Appellant?s motion to suppress; 2) overruling Appellant?s motions to determine competency. Appellant further assigns that her trial counsel provided ineffective assistance in 1) moving to determine competency rather than moving to continue trial; 2) stipulating to use evidence Appellant had sought to suppress; and 3) failing to preserve the issue of competency for appeal.
