Issues: Whether the trial court erred in assessing loss of earning power to the September 9, 2015 injury; whether the trial court?s decision that apportionment does not apply was clearly wrong; and whether there was a sufficient basis in law and fact to dispute payment of benefits, thus barring any claim for attorney fees and penalty.
