Civil Action: dissolution of marriage

Action Taken by Trial Court: The district court dissolved the parties marriage, divided the marital estate, and awarded custody, parenting time, and child support.

Assignments of Error on Appeal: Tracy assigns that the district court erred in (1) fashioning a visitation schedule that was neither reasonable nor in the best interests and contained vague and ambiguous provisions regarding pickup and drop off times and failed to provide safety provisions for a victim of domestic abuse; (2) allowing a non-disclosed exhibit and witness testimony; (3) finding her in contempt of a temporary order and ordering a purge plan that included \$2,500 in attorney fees; (4) developing a child support calculation contrary to the evidence and court's findings; (5) inequitably dividing the marital estate; and (6) failing to award her reasonable attorney fees.
