On September 6, 2006, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Two Committee on Inquiry, William D. Gilner, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. In a September 13 letter which this court filed on September 19, 2006 and treats as a Response to the Show Cause Order, respondent advised the Court that he received the show cause order.

Upon due consideration, this court finds that Respondent has not shown cause why he should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that William D. Gilner shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.
