On the application of William E. Mooney, Jr., Chairman of the District Two Committee of Inquiry of the Nebraska State Bar Association, for the temporary suspension of Timothy S. Egan, respondent, from the practice of law until final disposition of pending disciplinary proceedings, the Court finds:

- 1) That on October 16, 1990, the respondent was charged with criminal offenses in the United States District Court for the District of Nebraska, Docket CR 90-0-127;
- 2) That the conduct, if allowed to continue until final disposition of disciplinary proceedings, will cause serious damage to the public and to the legal profession; and
- 3) A temporary suspension of respondent is necessary to maintain the integrity and reputation of the Bar of this State.

It is therefore ordered that the respondent, Timothy S. Egan, is temporarily suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this Court.
