NOTICE RE: EVICTION MORATORIUM

WHEREAS on August 3, 2021, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) entered an Order under Section 361 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.) and § 2 Code of Federal Regulations 70.2 that Ordered a Temporary Halt in Residential Evictions to be extended until October 3, 2021 in counties experiencing substantial and high levels of community transmission levels.


WHEREAS a prior Administrative Order was entered on August 5, 2021 finding that the Moratorium **MUST BE** extended until October 3, 2021 or until further Order of the Court.

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2021, the Untitled States Supreme Court issued an opinion in the case captioned “Alabama Association of Realtors, et al. v. Department of Health and Human Services et al.” at 594 U.S. ____ (2021) vacating the CDC eviction moratorium issued on August 3, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, effective immediately the eviction moratorium applicable to Douglas County, Nebraska is now vacated and set aside by the Order of the United States Supreme Court and the moratorium is no longer applicable to eviction proceedings filed in in the Douglas County Court.
