Now on this 22nd day of April, 2019, this matter comes on for hearing on the Court's own motion to amend the order appointing Clerk Magistrates for the counties situated within the 11th judicial district as provided in 24-507, Revised Statutes of Nebraska 1943, as revised.

The Court having placed special trust and confidence in the integrity and ability of the following individuals hereby appoints each of them to the office of Clerk Magistrate in the counties as set forth below:

The Court further authorizes and empowers each of them to discharge the duties of said office according to law within each of the counties located in the 11th judicial district.

Pursuant to Section 24-519, Revised Statues of Nebraska, 1943, as amended, the Clerk Magistrates shall have authority to perform the following duties:

(1) To conduct any proceeding which is based on a misdemeanor, traffic infraction, violation of a city or village ordinance, or traffic violation or infraction under the laws of this state, except the trial of defendants who plead not guilty or for whom a not guilty plea has been entered. Any penalty imposed under this subdivision shall be made pursuant to a schedule adopted by the Supreme Court. Such schedule shall not provide for imprisonment;

(2) To conduct any proceeding for the issuance of warrants for arrest, or for searches and seizures within the county in which the property sought is located when no county or district judge is available in the judicial district;

(3) To hear and determine any non-felony proceeding for preliminary examination to determine probable cause or the release on bail of persons charged with bailable offenses;


(4) To determine temporary custody of a juvenile pursuant to section 43-253. An order of a clerk magistrate shall be reviewed by the county judge upon the written request of any party to the action within ten (10) days of the order. Such orders may be affirmed, modified, or set aside by the county judge;

(5) To hear and determine non-contested proceedings relating to decedent's estates, inheritance tax matters, and guardianship or conservatorship, except the matters relating to the construction of wills or trusts, the determination of title to real estate, and an authorization of the sale or mortgage of real estate shall not be heard by a clerk magistrate; and

(6) To enter orders for hearing and trials, including orders for garnishment and hearings on distribution of garnished funds.

IT IS THE FURTHER ORDER OF THE COURT that the aforementioned individuals are appointed Clerk Magistrates of the County as set forth. This appointment as Clerk Magistrate is to take effect and be in full force on and after the date which the appointee was appointed and shall satisfactorily perform all the duties imposed upon such appointee by law or unless sooner removed by Order of the County Judges.

IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THE COURT that a copy of this order or any subsequent amendments thereto be filed and recorded in the office of the County Judge in each of the respective counties in the 11th Judicial District.
