**ORDER AMENDING PREVIOUS
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS**

Paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Court's previous Administrative Order of May 29, 2020, is modified as follows:

Paragraph 4. Persons may enter the courthouse without a face covering or a mask and conduct business in the courthouse without a face covering or mask in non-courtroom areas. While persons are not required to have a face covering or mask, they are encouraged to utilize a face covering or mask to prevent the spread of viruses.

Persons entering the district courtroom must wear a face covering or mask, scarf or other device completely covering and concealing their noses and mouths. Masks may not be removed while in the courtroom except by permission of the court.

Any visitors seeking entry to the Hall County District Courtrooms without a mask will be provided a mask and if a mask is unavailable for any reason, the sheriff will suspend entry into the district courtrooms until the person contacts the court to be visited to explore alternate accommodations.

All persons seeking entry into the Hall County Courthouse shall be administered a temperature check and shall be denied entry if they refuse to have their temperature checked or have a fever of 100 degrees or higher.

Paragraph 5. No more than 20 persons may occupy the courtroom at any time (not including court personnel).

All other provisions of the Order of May 29, 2020, remain in full force and effect and will be reviewed and modified prior to July 1, 2020.
