**AMENDED
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE
OF DOUGLAS COUNTY,
NEBRASKA**


Douglas County Court modifies its operations as outlined below. The following changes are **effective November 1, 2022**, unless otherwise noted:

1. Courtroom 226: Traffic pretrials and trials will be heard Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 9:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. On Thursdays, pretrials and trials shall be heard at 1:30 p.m. only.
2. Courtroom 227: Criminal pretrials and trials shall be heard Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 9:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.
 - All Gun Appeals, Motions (except Motions in Limine) and Extradition Hearings shall be scheduled and heard by the assigned Judge in Courtroom 227 on Thursdays at 1:30 p.m.
 - Motions in Limine shall be scheduled before the assigned Judge in either Courtroom 226 or 227 at either 9:00 a.m or 1:30 p.m.
3. Courtroom 625: Preliminary Hearings and Out of Custody Felony First Appearances shall be heard in Courtroom 625 at 9:00 a.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
4. Courtroom 50/331 shall operate as follows:
 - All matters will continue to be heard via WebEx videoconferencing.
 - Mondays - All felony and misdemeanor cases shall be heard at 12:30 p.m.
 - Tuesdays and Wednesdays – Felony cases shall be heard at 9:00 a.m. Misdemeanor cases shall be heard at 1:00 p.m.
 - Thursdays - All felony and misdemeanor cases shall be heard at 1:00 p.m.
 - Fridays - Felony cases shall be heard at 9:00 a.m. Felony and Misdemeanor cases shall be heard at 1:00 p.m.
 - “Time and cost” pleas may be scheduled at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
 - Counsel may schedule pleas with agreed upon Probation sentences at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays if the assigned Judge is on the bench in the Jail Courtroom.
5. Courtroom 228 shall operate as follows:
 - Arraignments shall be heard at 9:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m., except on Thursdays.
 - Thursdays – Arraignments and Diversion Checks shall be heard at 1:30 p.m.
6. All in-custody Probation pleas and bond reviews shall only go before the assigned Judge.
7. Request files may only be scheduled in Courtroom 228 if the assigned Judge is not on the bench in another criminal/traffic courtroom.

8. Sentencings and Protection Order hearings shall be held each Thursday at the assigned Judges' designated time and courtroom.
9. Civil Jury Trials shall resume at the direction of each Judge.
10. **Effective December 1, 2022**, Courtroom 229 shall operate as follows:
 - a. Arraignments shall be heard on Mondays, Tuesday, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 9:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.
 - b. Thursdays - Diversion Checks, Extradition Checks and Arraignments shall be heard at 1:30 p.m.
 - c. Courtroom 229 shall be closed at 9:00 a.m. on Criminal Jury Pretrials Days and other days as ordered by the Presiding Judge or Designee.
11. Any prior Administrative Order of this Court that conflicts with this Order is hereby rescinded.
