NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF THE EVICTION MORATORIUM

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has entered an Order Under Section 361 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 264) and §2 Code of Federal Regulations 70.2 that has Orders a Temporary Halt in Residential Evictions in Communities with Substantial or High Levels of Community Transmission of COVID-19 to Prevent the Further Spread of COVID-19.

WHEREAS, CDC has extended the federal eviction moratorium through October 3, 2021 in counties experiencing substantial and high levels of community transmission levels.

WHEREAS, with information and guidance from and in conjunction with the Nebraska Supreme Court, Douglas County is experiencing significant levels of virus spread and is in the HIGH category under the CDC Order.

NOW THEREFORE, the eviction moratorium MUST BE extended until October 3, 2021 or until a further Order of the Court.
