In consultation with the medical director of Douglas County Health Department, the courtrooms of Douglas County Court are to remain open with restricted public access to courtrooms located in the Hall of Justice and Civic Center until April 20, 2020 or until further Order of the court

The County Court shall remain open and accessible for in-person hearings, including, but not limited to, protection order hearings, evictions and garnishment exemption requests. The court shall also remain open to allow members of the public to apply for protection orders, pay fines, cancel a warrant and file legal pleadings. All members of the public will be escorted by security in and out of the building until April 20, 2020 or until further Order of this court. All Directed Health Measure Orders will be strictly enforced.

All prisoner transports from Douglas County Corrections and Douglas County Youth Center to the Douglas County Court are suspended until April 20, 2020 or until further Order of this court.
