**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF
THE DISTRICT COURTS IN HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA**


The Governor and the Central Nebraska Health Department having issued Community Health Directives for Hall County until April 30, 2020, the following procedures are to be followed:

1. All civil hearings not requiring testimony and all civil pretrials shall be conducted by telephone. The parties shall submit exhibits to the court by email or efile no later than 24 hours before the hearing;
2. In all matters requiring presentation of testimony the parties shall confer before the scheduled hearing date and make arrangements to ensure that no more than eight persons including counsel are present at any time within the courtroom or its close environs;
3. In all criminal cases defense counsel shall confer with their clients prior to any scheduled arraignment and discuss waiving arraignment. If defendant chooses not to waive arraignment, counsel shall contact the court and make arrangements for either a video arraignment or an arraignment scheduled after April 30, 2020;
4. All prior orders regarding criminal pretrials and mental health board proceedings remain in full force and effect.


