And further after consultation with the offices of the Lancaster County Attorney, the Lincoln City Attorney and the Lancaster County Public Defender's Office;

THE COURT FINDS that good cause exists to suspend the execution of warrants during the period from March 27, 2020 to and including June 30, 2020 on those individuals with corresponding case numbers enumerated on that certain list attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. In keeping with this Order, during the period from March 27, 2020 to and including June 30, 2020, in the event law enforcement makes contact with an individual on the attached list who has a corresponding warrant, said individual should be released on that warrant and the warrant should remain pending.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the execution of warrants during the period from March 27, 2020 to and including June 30, 2020 on those individuals with corresponding case numbers enumerated on that certain list attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference should be, and hereby is, suspended. In the event law enforcement make contact with an individual during the period from March 27, 2020 to and including June 30, 2020 whose name appears on the attached list and who has a corresponding warrant, said individual is ordered to be released on that warrant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that nothing in this Order shall require law enforcement to release an individual whose warrant is suspended as provided herein or who would otherwise be released on said warrant if

the individual has additional warrants pending. In such event, said individual may be detained and shall be required to resolve each such warrant, including that suspended by this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that any warrant suspended by reason of this Order shall be considered not to have been delivered into the hands of any sheriff or officer to be executed and such sheriff or officer shall be relieved of his or her duty to serve the same.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
