## BAR EXAM SCORE REQUEST

On January 14, 2015, amendments to Neb. Ct. R. §3-119(A) became effective. Under the amended rules, Class 1A motion applicants must provide an official copy of their bar exam **composite scaled score** so that eligibility for admission may be determined. Pursuant to §3-119(A), the applicant must pass a bar exam that is “equivalent to” the exam administered in Nebraska and attain a score that is “at least equivalent to” the passing score required by Nebraska.

To fulfill this requirement the score may be provided in any of the following formats:

- 1) a copy of the applicant’s official notification of bar exam results, or
- 2) a written report from the bar admitting authority provided directly to the Nebraska Director of Admissions, or
- 3) a score report from the National Conference of Bar Examiners.

Please note that to fulfill this requirement the composite score must represent a single administration of the bar exam.
