On ______, this matter came before the court for its consideration of placing the guardianship/conservatorship case on the waiting list of the Nebraska Office of Public Guardian. The court finds and orders:

- 1. The Office of Public Guardian was nominated to serve as guardian/conservator.
- 2. The Office of Public Guardian has filed a Verification of No Caseload Capacity.
- 3. An Order Denying the Appointment of the Public Guardian due to no caseload capacity was previously entered.
- 4. In consideration of Neb. Ct. R. § 6-1433.01(J), the court finds that proper notice was given to the Office of Public Guardian; the petitioner has acted in good faith and due diligence to identify a guardian or conservator who would serve in the best interest of the alleged incapacitated person; the appointment of the Office of Public Guardian would be necessary, but that no current caseload capacity exists to serve the individual by the Office of Public Guardian, as set forth by statute; and the visitor or guardian ad litem report as outlined in these procedures has been completed and supports the appointment of the Office of Public Guardian, all options available to support the individual in the least restrictive manner possible has been explored, and the guardianship is a last resort.

The OPG has approved placement on the waiting list.
The case is Ordered placed on the Office of Public Guardian Waiting List for the next 90 days.
Within 90 days, the OPG shall file a Notice of Removal from OPG Waiting List (CC 16:2.414) or Office of Public Guardian Acceptance of Nomination from Waiting List (CC 16:2.415).
