TO: Guardians and Conservators

On April 16, 2014, the Nebraska Supreme Court passed changes to Nebraska Supreme Court Rule § 6-1433 that requires any governmental agency paying benefits on behalf of the ward, incapacitated person, protected person, or minor; to be considered an interested person in a guardianship or conservatorship. This means that if your ward/incapacitated person/protected person gets social security or V.A. benefits, for example, you must send a copy of your annual report to the governmental agency. This is in addition to any other interested persons to whom you are currently sending reports and notice.
