Nebraska Judicial Branch

WHEREAS, Approximately 600 trial court staff employed by the Nebraska Judicial Branch and the counties directly serve and support the trial courts, including judges, justice stakeholders, and the public.

WHEREAS, Justice stakeholders and the public are more likely to interact with trial court staff than anyone else in the court system;

WHEREAS, The administration of justice at the trial court level plays an important role in influencing the overall impression of the Nebraska judicial system.

WHEREAS, Trial court staff work diligently to ensure the fair administration of justice.

WHEREAS, Trial court staff continually strive to improve court operations and facilitate access to justice by participating in Judicial Branch Education.

WHEREAS, Trial court staff have tirelessly assisted their judges during the COVID-19 pandemic with modifying court operations, implementing procedures and complying with relevant emergency orders to ensure the safety of all who work in or must appear before the trial courts.

WHEREAS, Trial court staff are integral members of their communities and are dedicated to preserving the public trust and confidence in the judicial system.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael G. Heavican, Chief Justice of the Nebraska Supreme Court, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the week of March 21 through 25, 2022, as
