

For purposes of remarriage, neither the plaintiff nor the defendant may remarry anyone anywhere in the world for six months after this decree is filed with the clerk of the district court. For the purposes of continuation of health insurance coverage, the decree shall become final and operative six months after the decree is entered. 10.
