
COMPLETING THE DECREE FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE (Children) (Service by Publication)

Use this form to provide a proposed Divorce Decree (Order) to the court.

Check with the clerk's office after the final hearing to update any information, including information for the vital statistics form.

The decree must be filed with the clerk of the court before it can be finalized.

If you serve your spouse by publication, the court may not be able to award child support.

- 9. The plaintiff's former name of ________, (former or maiden name, including first, middle and last names) should be restored to her.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

10. The marriage between the plaintiff, and the defendant, is hereby dissolved. Except for review on appeal, remarriage, and continuation of the health insurance coverage, this Decree shall become final and operative 30 days after this Decree is filed or on the date of death of one of the parties, whichever occurs first. For purposes of remarriage, neither the plaintiff nor the defendant may remarry anyone anywhere in the world for six months after this Decree is filed with the clerk of the district court.
