FINDINGS OF FACT

_____ The Court makes the following specific factual findings and legal conclusions:

- Based upon these findings and conclusions, the Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that the pregnant woman is both sufficiently mature and well-informed to decide whether to have an abortion.
- Based upon these findings and conclusions, the Court finds that there is not clear and convincing evidence that the petitioner is sufficiently mature and well-informed enough to decide whether to have an abortion.

_____ The Court makes the following specific factual findings and legal conclusions:

- Based upon these findings and conclusions, the Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that there is evidence of abuse as defined in Section 28-351, sexual abuse as defined in Section 28-367, or child abuse or neglect as defined in Section 28-710 of the pregnant woman by a parent or a guardian, or that an abortion without the consent of a parent or a guardian is in the best interest of the pregnant woman.
- Based upon these findings and conclusions, the Court does not find clear and convincing evidence that the petitioner was the victim of abuse, sexual abuse, or child abuse or neglect, or that an abortion without the consent of a parent or a guardian is in the best interest of the pregnant woman.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED

_____ In compliance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 71-6903, the Court authorizes the pregnant woman to consent to the performance or inducement of an abortion without the consent of a parent or a guardian.

OR

_____ The petition for waiver of parental consent is dismissed. Petitioner is notified of her right to appeal this decision to the Nebraska Supreme Court.
