- 858 youth have accessed funds for **Community-Based Non-Treatment** services.

As predicted by the validated risk assessment tool, Youth Level of Risk/Case Management Inventory (YLS/CMI), the total population of low risk youth who discharged successfully between December 31, 2017 and December 31, 2018 recidivated at a lower rate than the total population of moderate or high risk youth
