ORDER

On December 22, 2020, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Six Committee on Inquiry, Patrick J. Nelson, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this Court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this State. Respondent did not file a response.

Upon due consideration, this Court finds that Respondent has not shown cause why he should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Patrick J. Nelson is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Patrick J. Nelson shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316, of the Disciplinary Rules of this Court and, upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this Court.
