Referrals to this service are managed by Probation staff to ensure equitable distribution and appropriate prioritization of referrals between service providers in the same coverage area.

**Multisystemic Therapy (MST)** is a family-driven intensive model of treatment based on evidence-based interventions that target high-risk behavior in youth and increase protective factors that targets youth ages 12 to 18 and their families who have antisocial, aggressive, or a history of violent behaviors.



Juvenile Justice Home-Based Initiative oversight ensures the proper utilization of this service, the use of which will allow more youth to remain in their homes and communities. Referrals to this service are managed by Probation staff to ensure equitable distribution and appropriate prioritization of referrals between service providers in the same coverage area.

**Short-Term Crisis Stabilization Center** placement assists juveniles and families in returning to a pre-crisis level of functioning. Upon stabilization, the focus will be to assist juveniles and families in accessing additional support services that will continue to help maintain functioning within their home or community setting upon discharge.

Duration: Designed for 1-7 days; not to exceed 30 days

**Shelter:** Short-term residential service designed to provide support to youth that require an immediate out-of-home placement because of safety concerns in their family home or because of disrupted placement.

Duration: Designed not to exceed 30 days.

## Alternative to Detention-Emergency Professional Foster Care (EPFC)

**EPFC:** Temporary placement in a family setting that is provided through an agency supported, licensed foster home. EPFC provides a short-term, structured, home environment to stabilize and assist in preparing the youth for an immediate transition home, or to a community-based or treatment placement following the detention/court hearing.

Duration: Five days. Can be extended up to 14 days with administrative approval.

#### Detention (Secure and Staff Secure)

**Staff Secure:** (Nebraska §83-4,125) a juvenile residential facility operated by a political subdivision (a) which does not include construction designed to physically restrict the movements and activities of juveniles who are in custody in the facility, (b) in which physical restriction of movement or activity of juveniles is provided solely through staff, (c) which may establish reasonable rules restricting ingress to and egress from the facility, and (d) in which the movements and activities of individual juvenile residents may, for treatment purposes, be restricted or subject to control through the use of intensive staff supervision. Staff secure juvenile facility does not include any institution operated by the department.

**Secure Detention:** (Nebraska §43-245) detention in a highly structured, residential, hardware-secured facility designed to restrict a juvenile's movement

#### Group Home A and B and RESTORE

**Group Home A (GH A)**: A residential service in a group setting utilizing 24-hour awake staff to provide safety and security for the group home environment and the community. Duration: 4-6 months,

**Group Home B (GH B)**: Refer to definition for Group Home A; however, youth at this level do not require awake overnight staff to maintain safety and security in the home. Duration: 4-6 months

**RESTORE**: Specialized Restorative Residential Program (RESTORE) is a licensed, temporary, non-treatment facility providing 24-hour highly skilled supervision, intensified structure, and evidence informed interventions for high risk/high needs juvenile justice youth with well-established patterns of risky behavior and serious behavioral and/or emotional challenges in an age-appropriate, individualized, and structured group setting. Duration: up to 6 months

#### Independent Living

Staff members provide assistance, skill-training, and support to youth living independently or with a roommate who is also an independent living youth. For juveniles 17-18 years old.

Duration: 6 to 12 months

#### Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility (PRTF)

**Psychiatric residential treatment facility** services are clinically necessary services provided to a client who requires 24-hour professional psychiatric care and treatment in a highly structured, closely-supervised environment. Professional care and treatment means care and treatment identified as medically necessary that can be expected to reduce or eliminate the client's mental health and/or substance use dysfunctions.

Duration: Average 60 days; Not to exceed 6 months

Therapeutic group homes are facilities are a home-like environment with an organized, professional staff who deliver safety, supervision, rehabilitation services, and treatment services.

## **Probation Provided**

#### Services Available Statewide

These services are provided by probation officers/staff within every probation district. Facilitated groups may include supervision groups, cognitive programs, or skill-building, life skills enhancement, and general education of juveniles.

#### Education Group

#### 1. Real Colors

- A. Program Component:
  - i. The Real Colors Program is a strength-based, one-time education class designed to assist juveniles in identifying their temperament type to better understand human behavior and specifics about personality temperaments in order to improve communication with others.
- B. Target Population:
  - i. Juveniles assessed as high risk and a supportive adult
- C. Program Outcomes:
  - i. Understanding of self-temperament style and how others think, feel, and behave according to their temperament style to enhance communication and understanding with other personalities.

#### **Cognitive Skill-Based Groups**

#### 1. Recognizing Increased Skills in Education (RISE)

- A. Program Component:
  - i. RISE is a skill-based program specifically targeting youth struggling in school academically, as well as with attendance and behaviors. RISE program specialists who are AmeriCorps members facilitate groups with a developed curriculum targeted for specific educational skills.
  - ii. The RISE program has five sessions focusing on goal setting, motivation, organization, class participation and study skills, and test taking with up to six months of ongoing support upon successful completion of the program.
- B. Target Population:
  - i. Those juveniles who score medium-high risk or have an elevated domain in the area of education. Additionally, this program can be used as a graduated sanction when a youth begins struggling in school.
- C. Program Outcomes:
  - i. Increased success at school including grades, attendance, and behavior. Reduction in returning to the probation system a year after program completion.

#### **Cognitive Restructuring Programming**

#### 2. Nebraska Aggression Replacement Training (NE-ART)

- A. Program Component:
  - i. Nebraska Aggression Replacement training (NE-ART) is a research-based model used to provide youth with a comprehensive program in social emotional learning.
  - ii. Through the curriculum, youth learn new skills to handle stressful situations, understand their emotions, and other's emotions in a positive way.
  - iii. The program consists of skill building designed to teach a broad curriculum targeting situations youth find themselves in regularly. Activities include modeling, role-playing, and performance feedback.
  - iv. Many youth do not have the necessary skill set to handle situations appropriately and this program gives them the ability to gain new skills. Habilitation is the process of learning new behaviors to appropriately respond to challenging situations.
  - v. NE-ART curriculum provides lessons of the three basic core components: social skills, self-control, and traps and traits. The program is an eight-week course where youth attend three times per week in a closed group setting.
  - vi. All youth need social emotional learning. Knowing empathy, self-control, social skills, and character education is fundamental for success in all areas of life.
- B. Target Population:
  - i. Juveniles assessed at a moderate to high-risk on the YLS/CMI.
- C. Program Outcomes:
  - i. NE-ART provides many benefits for youth to include: enhanced skills used for successful lives, increasing knowledge of self and others, helping to learn empathy for others, and self-control.
  - ii. Prior to a youth starting the program, orientation is held with the parent/caregiver. This is a key component as it brings a team approach to what will be learned in the coming weeks. Newly learned skills can be utilized in the home setting, which can be supported by the parents, caregiver, etc.
  - iii. Research on this curriculum has shown positive results in reducing recidivism in low skilled youth as well as aggressive youth.
  - iv. Upon graduation from the program, additional materials are provided for officers to continue skill training with their youth. These materials target specific stressful situations that youth encounter on a daily basis.

#### 3. Moral Recognition Therapy (MRT)

- A. Program Component:
  - i. MRT is a systematic, cognitive-behavioral, step-by-step treatment strategy designed to enhance self-image, promote growth of a positive, productive identity, and facilitate the development of higher stages of moral reasoning. Why MRT? Numerous outcome studies show that MRT significantly increases moral reasoning levels, enhances life purpose, facilitates increased social support and gives participants more perceived control over their lives. One way to assist probationers in the change process is through the implementation of Cognitive Programming. Moral Recognition Therapy is an Evidenced-Based Practice that research outcomes support significantly lowers recidivism for program participants. MRT is rooted in Social Learning Theory, Lawrence Kohlberg's' Theory on Moral Reasoning, and Erik Ericksons' Human Development Theory.
  - ii. Probation officers utilize a standard manual curriculum and are specifically trained to facilitate all the MRT exercises according to program fidelity. This is an open group curriculum which means new members can enter the group at any time.
- B. Target Population:
  - i. Juveniles aged 16 and above, assessed as Moderate to Very High on the YLS, elevated risk domains of Attitude Orientation, Pro-criminal Orientation and Alcohol/Drug Use.
- C. Program Outcomes:
  - i. Designed to increase participants' level of moral reasoning, improve self-identity replacing faulty thinking patterns with healthy thinking patterns, which leads to better decision-making. Learn how to heal damaged relationships, importance of contributing to their community and setting long-term and short-term goals.

#### **Probation Specific Case Management Strategies**

#### **Specialized Case Loads**

Several probation districts have probation officers that have specialized skills such as mental health licensing, drug and alcohol counseling, or treatment officers. This specialized knowledge is beneficial when working with high-risk individuals who also display needs in the areas of behavioral health, substance use, and mental health treatment needs. Additionally, treatment officers are utilized as a resource in the districts for their knowledge of current trends within the behavioral health community. There are some probation officers who receive specific training in the areas of sexually problematic behaviors. In addition to standard training, these officers are trained in evidenced-based practices for juveniles who sexually harm.

The Juvenile Reentry Unit (JRU) is a specialized probation unit serving youth who have been committed to the Youth Rehabilitation Treatment Centers (YRTC) and youth at Whitehall Psychiatric Residencial Treatment Facility (PRTF). The JRU helps serve as liaisons between probation and DHHS. The JRU is tasked with streamlining communication between the facilities, stakeholders, and home probation districts by helping to identify exhausted efforts. This unit provides Individualized Reentry Plans (IRP) for youth discharging from YRTC and Individual Transition Plans (ITP) for youth completing PRTF treatment.

The main objective for the JRU is to assist in thinking outside the box regarding aftercare services, identifying community-based providers and pro-social activities that will assist youth successfully re-enter the community. The JRU provides constructive feedback and knowledge to assist the team in making educated decisions prior to discharge. The JRU strives to be the experts in services available, utilizing appropriate providers statewide and implement best practices during the reentry period. One of the most powerful tools the JRU has is to provide meaningful engagement with youth on a regular basis at each facility and act as a resource to help support them along their journey. Even after the youth return home, the JRU stay involved with them to check in and give support.

#### **Motivational Interviewing**

Motivational Interviewing (MI) is a style of communication that helps people explore and resolve ambivalence about changing specific, maladaptive behaviors. Created by two preeminent social scientists, William Miller and Stephen Rollnick, this Evidenced-Based Practice (EBP) enhances our opportunity for accomplishing our Vision and Mission of reducing recidivism, establishing long-term behavior change and enhanced community safety. Staff utilization of Motivational Interviewing is imperative in our commitment to implementation of EBP. Motivational Interviewing enables employees a communication approach designed to mobilize an individual's internal desire for change and to resolve ambivalence for continued change. We recognize that changing behavior, thinking. and attitudes are necessary for long-term change. Motivational Interviewing assists us in our work with justice-involved youth and their families for better engagement, to encourage and support change.

Motivational Interviewing Training

- 1. New Probation Officer Phase I Motivational Interviewing Skill Training (3 days)
- 2. New Probation Officer Phase II Motivational Interviewing Skill Training (2 ½ days)
- 3. Phase III (Advanced) Motivational Interviewing Skill Training for Specialized Officers (3 days)
- 4. Motivational Interviewing Skill training for Support Staff, Drug Technicians, and RISE Specialists
- 5. Motivational Interviewing Skill training for Managers (coming soon)

#### Family Team Meetings

Family Team Meetings are case planning meetings that involve the youth, their family, other formal/informal supports, Probation Officer, applicable treatment or non-treatment service providers, and any other stakeholders in the youth's probation case. These meetings will occur, per statute, a minimum of one time a month while a youth is in YRTC placement. However, these meetings are essential in all probation cases as the Probation officer uses responsive case management skills to facilitate assessment of the youth's progress and readiness to return to a prosocial lifestyle in their home and community.

#### AC4E Initiative

Nebraska Probation has adopted a method of case management for individuals on probation referred to as AC4E: Advanced Coaching for Excellence. AC4E guides probation officers through four core components of case management aimed at building skills in individuals to reduce risk and promote successful release from probation. The four core components of AC4E are:

#### 1. Assessment, Case Planning, Case Management

Probation officers are highly trained to identify top criminogenic risk factors through the use of a validated risk assessment instrument. The probation officer uses the youth's individual risk, need and responsivity to guide targeted interventions and case planning.

#### 2. Engagement to Enhance Motivation

Quality engagement is extremely impactful for successful probation outcomes and is an evidence-based practice. Probation officers are highly engaged with youth and families and utilize the HOPE method: <u>H</u>umanity, <u>O</u>ptimism, <u>P</u>erspective, and <u>E</u>mpathy. Each person's individual perspective is valued, and their story is honored. Probation officers demonstrate and model empathy by listening to understand, being transparent, neutral, and trustworthy.

#### 3. Incentives & Sanctions

Research suggests that incentivizing positive behavior correlates to long-term behavior change in youth. Probation officers utilize tangible and non-tangible incentives as positive behavior changes are observed. Incentives must be meaningful to youth to be effective and probation officers utilize engagement strategies to learn what motivates a youth.

At times, behaviors occur that are not in accordance with the youth's probation order. In these instances, the officer will sanction the youth to address the negative behavior. Probation officers tie sanctions to skill building opportunities to decrease the chances of the behavior repeating.

#### 4. Skill Train with Directed Practice

Skill training is a core principle and practice within probation. Probation officers work directly with probation youth to teach skills that habilitate new responses to undesirable behaviors. Skill training with youth can be done individually or in groups and allows youth to practice new behavior responses to challenging situations so they can learn to respond in an appropriate manner.

Electronic monitoring (EM) is an electronic system for high-risk youth to enhance community safety. There are two types of EM technology used by probation: Radio Frequency (RF) and Global Positioning System (GPS).
