Category	Treatment	
Setting	Professional office environment, clinic, mental health substance use treatment center, private practice, teleservice or other setting appropriate to the provision of outpatient services.	
Facility License	As required by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) – Division of Public Health.	
Service Description	Medication Management is the level of outpatient treatment where the sole service rendered by a qualified prescriber is the evaluation of the individual's need for psychotherapeutic medications, provision of a prescription and ongoing medical monitoring of those medications. After an Initial Diagnostic Interview (Medication Prescriber Only), Medication Management provides for follow-up appointments to assist in monitoring/adjusting medications.	
Service Expectations	This service will include the following:
