ORDER OF SUSPENSION.

Alexander M. Jarrin was admitted to the practice of law in the State of Nebraska on February 26, 1971.

On September 22, 2000, the Illinois Supreme Court suspended respondent from the practice of law in Illinois for at least 1 year. On November 13, a motion for reciprocal discipline was filed by the Counsel for Discipline of the Nebraska Supreme Court. On November 22, this Court entered an order for respondent to show cause why his license to practice law in this state should not be suspended until further order of this Court. The Sheriff's return of service was filed with the Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court on January 26, 2001.

Cause having not been shown,


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that respondent be suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this Court effective upon the entry of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should respondent move for reinstatement, such motion shall include a showing that respondent has been reinstated in Illinois.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon respondent by the Sheriff of Rock Island County, Illinois.
