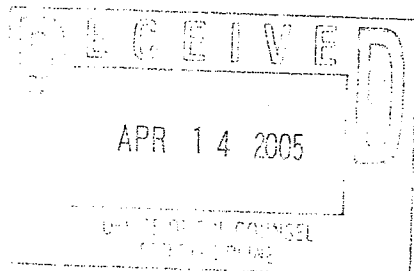
ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Before the court are Respondent's Motion and Amended Motion for Rehearing and Reinstatement. Upon consideration of the materials accompanying those motions, the court determines that the motions should be granted and respondent's license to practice law in this state should be reinstated on a two-year probationary basis as set forth in the judgment of suspension entered on April 23, 2004.
