

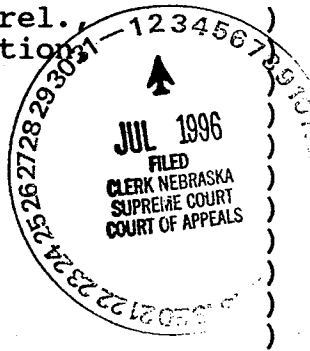

ORDER OF TEMPORARY  
SUSPENSION

On June 19, 1996, pursuant to an application of representatives of the Nebraska State Bar Association, this court entered an order for attorney Gary L. Dolan to show cause why his license to practice law in this state should not be temporarily suspended he having been convicted by a jury in the U.S. District Court for Nebraska of two counts of violating provisions of Title 18 U.S.C. §§ 2, 152 and 271 (bankruptcy fraud and conspiracy to commit bankruptcy fraud).

The show cause order provided that the temporary suspension of Dolan's license to practice law in this state would continue until final disposition of the charges against him.

On June 26, 1996, Dolan filed his voluntary consent to the entry of an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. In his consent, Dolan stated he waived any right he may have to notice, appearance or a hearing prior to the entry of the order of temporarily suspending his license to practice law in Nebraska.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Gary L. Dolan's license to practice law in Nebraska be and it hereby is suspended until final disposition of the charges against him.
