ORDER

On April 1, 2003, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension filed in this case by the Vice-Chair of the District Two Committee on Inquiry, Scott H. Rasmussen was ordered to show cause why this Court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. Scott H. Rasmussen has filed a response resisting the entry of an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in the State of Nebraska.


Upon due consideration of the response, this court finds that Scott H. Rasmussen has not shown cause why he should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Scott H. Rasmussen is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Scott H. Rasmussen shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served on Scott H. Rasmussen by certified United States mail.
