On March 12, 2004, an Application for Temporary Suspension of Respondent, Gregg E. Williams, was filed by the Chair of the District One Committee on Inquiry. On March 15, 2004, Respondent's Affidavit and Consent to Order of Temporary Suspension was filed with this court. In his Affidavit, Respondent knowingly, freely, and voluntarily waived notice, appearance and hearing prior to the entry of an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state.

Upon due consideration of the Application and Respondent's Affidavit, this court finds that Respondent should be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Gregg E. Williams is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Gregg E. Williams shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served on Gregg E. Williams by certified United States mail.
