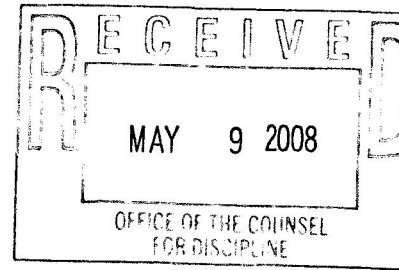

ORDER



On March 31, 2008, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Two Committee on Inquiry, David R. Tarvin, Jr., Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. No response was filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that David R. Tarvin, Jr. is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that David R. Tarvin, Jr. shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.
