

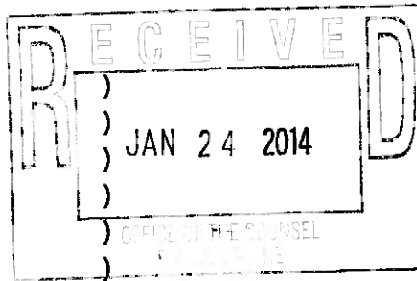

ORDER

On December 18, 2013, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Four Committee on Inquiry, David E. Pavel, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this court should not enter an order temporarily suspending his license to practice law in this state. A response was filed on January 14, 2014.

Upon due consideration, this court finds that Respondent has not shown cause why he should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that David E. Pavel is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska effective immediately until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that David E. Pavel shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316, of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served on David E. Pavel by certified United States mail.
