The "Joint Motion for Judgment in Conformance with the Report and Recommended Sanction of the Referee" filed September 9, 2014, is before the Court for consideration. The Referee Report filed September 4, 2014, recommends that respondent be suspended from the practice of law for a period of 30 days.

Being fully advised in the premises, the Court sustains the motion and HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

1. Respondent, Robert John Meyer, is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska for a period of 30 days effective on the date of the filing of this order.
2. Respondent shall be automatically reinstated 30 days after the effective date of this order.
3. Respondent shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. § 3-316, of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon his failure to do so, he shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.




4. Respondent is directed to pay costs and expenses in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 7-114 and 7-115 (Reissue 2012) and Neb. Ct. R. §§ 3-310(P) and 3-323(B) of the disciplinary rules within 60 days after the order imposing costs and expenses, if any, is entered by the court.
