ORDER OF DISBARMENT

On September 9, 1999, pursuant to a Motion for Reciprocal Discipline made by the Counsel for Discipline of the Nebraska State Bar Association, Jackie Bailey, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this court should not enter an order disbaring her from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska. Respondent received service of the order to show cause on October 12, 1999. Respondent did not file a response to the show cause order.

Respondent was admitted to the practice of law in Nebraska on September 22, 1980. Respondent was disbarred from the practice of law in Missouri on October 28, 1996, based on various uncontested acts of neglect and mismanagement of trust accounts, and failed to report the fact of disbarment to the Nebraska State Bar Association, as required by Neb. Ct. R. of Discipline 21(A) (rev. 1997).

According to rule 21(A), this court is authorized to reciprocate the disciplinary measures of another state on a member of the Nebraska bar. For purposes of reciprocal disciplinary actions, a judicial determination of attorney misconduct in one state is conclusive proof of guilt and is not subject to relitigation in the second state. *State ex rel. NSBA v. Ramacciotti*, 250 Neb. 893, 553 N.W.2d 467 (1996).

Upon due consideration and in view of Respondent's lack of response to the show cause order, this court finds that the Respondent should be disbarred from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Jackie Bailey is disbarred from the practice of law in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Respondent shall forthwith comply with Neb. Ct. R. of Discipline 16, and upon her failure to do so, she shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.

The Clerk of the Nebraska Supreme Court is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served on the Respondent by certified United States mail.
