On February 28, 2007, pursuant to an Application for Temporary Suspension made by the Chair of the District Five Committee on Inquiry, Jane K. Brogan, Respondent, was ordered to show cause why this court should not enter an order temporarily suspending her license to practice law in this state. No response was filed.

Upon due consideration, this court finds that Respondent has not shown cause why she should not be temporarily suspended from the practice of law until further order of this court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Jane K. Brogan shall forthwith comply with Rule 16 of the Disciplinary Rules of this court, and upon her failure to do so, she shall be subject to punishment for contempt of this court.
