See Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-1912(3) (Cum. Supp. 2022). Therefore, this court lacks jurisdiction. See Green v. Seiffert, 304 Neb. 212, 933 N.W.2d 590 (2019) (appellate court lacks jurisdiction over order denying untimely motion for reconsideration even if timely appealed if motion merely contends initial order rejecting claim was erroneous).
