See, e.g., State v. Dunster, 270 Neb. 773, 707 N.W.2d 412 (2005); State v. Weathers, 30 Neb. App. 189, 966 N.W.2d 72 (2021). If the district court lacked jurisdiction to hear the matter, so does this court. State v. Weathers, supra. In addition, Appellant failed to properly perfect his appeal from the district court's July 26, 2024, denial of in forma pauperis status. See, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-1912(1) (Cum. Supp. 2022); State v. Carter, 292 Neb. 16, 870 N.W.2d 641 (2015).
