TRAUMA AFFECT REGULATION: GUIDE FOR EDUCATION & THERAPY (TARGET)

TRAINING OPPORTUNITY: The Juvenile Probation Services Division is offering, at no cost, training and all necessary materials for certification in Trauma Affect Regulation: Guide for Education and Therapy. (TARGET) for up to 30 Registered Service Providers.

TARGET® is a manualized, strengths-based, present-centered, educational psychotherapeutic intervention. It has been evaluated and recognized by SAMHSA's National Registry of Evidenced-based Programs and Practices as an effective program for preventing and treating Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).

THE COMMITMENT:

To achieve certification, participants must complete two days of in-person training, followed by four quarterly, 3-hour live web-based coaching sessions with self-paced online course materials, occurring in August & November of 2025, and February & May of 2026. Attendance and participation at all sessions is required.

TRAINING SCHEDULE:

- In person: **June 2nd & 3rd 2025 in Lincoln, Nebraska at 8:30 am - 5:00 pm both days.**
- Quarterly Coaching Sessions: **Occurring AUG & NOV 2025 and FEB & MAY 2026.**

APPLY NOW: Applicants will be evaluated competitively gauging interest, experience, and commitment to participating in the advancement of Juvenile Justice System Enhancement (JJSEN) goals. Up to 30 providers will be selected to meet Juvenile Probation referral needs statewide.

PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Current Registered Service Provider, preferably providing mental health services to justice involved youth.
- Attend and actively participate in each session of the complementary training (In-person & live web-based components).
- Pay own travel and lodging costs to attend the 2-day in-person training in Lincoln, NE on June 2nd and 3rd. Lunch will be provided but participants are responsible for all other meals.
- Be willing to support Juvenile Probation Services Division referral needs.
- Agree to sign the Training Services Agreement with Advanced Trauma Solutions Professionals (ATS Pro), who have the exclusive license to conduct all TARGET® training. This agreement includes, for example, confidentiality, HIPPA, and copyright provisions, but excludes training fees that will be covered by the Juvenile Probation Services Division.
